Process for Transferring Guardianship to Arizona from another State

- 1. The Guardian/Conservator petitions the court in the other state to authorize the Guardian/Conservator to petition the court in Arizona for guardianship.
- 2. The Guardian/Conservator petitions the court in Arizona to accept the guardianship or conservatorship.
 - There is no pre-printed form for this action.
 - The petition must include:
 - A certified copy of the other state's order authorizing the guardian or conservator to petition the court of Arizona for guardianship, conservatorship or other protective order.
 - A certified copy of the other state's order granting guardianship or conservatorship.
- 3. Notice of a petition must be given to interested parties in both states.
 - Notice must be provided as if the petition were a petition for the appointment of a guardian or entry of a protective order in both the transferring state and Arizona.
- 4. File the petition with the court in Arizona.
